

Emotional Photographics

Appropriate for Grades: 3 up

Overview:

Give the students digital cameras and get them to take photographs of each other's faces displaying a range of emotions. Use these photographs to produce a poster of emotional responses.

Activity:

- Discuss and look at the different faces students pull when showing different emotions.
- Plan a list of 'must get' emotions.
- Check that all digital cameras are fully charged.
- Give the cameras to students to begin taking photographs.
- Working in pairs or teams, the students take the 'must get' photos and any others that they have time to complete.
- Download each of the cameras into a shared folder so that all students can choose from them.
- Open a Word Processor or desktop publishing program.
- Add a title / heading.
- Adjust the font, size and color.
- Import the photographs from the shared folder.
- Add captions to each of the photographs.
- Switch to print preview and check the layout of the poster.
- Save and print a copy for display.

- Software: Word Processor, desktop publishing program
- Paper / Printer
- Digital cameras
- Students
